By 1981 he got his graduation in Computer Science at Faculdade de Ciências e Tecnologia of Universidade Nova de Lisboa and by 1979 he got a Bachelor in Electronic and Telecommunications at Instituto Superior de Engenharia de Lisboa. He has participated in three European research projects: In the WATERNET- Knowledge Capture for Advanced Supervision of Water Distributions Networks, project Esprit IV n° 22.186, he was the promoter and co-ordinator of the project. In the BRITE project n° BE-3653, “CIMTOFI - Cim System with Improved Capabilities for Furniture Industry”, participated as the local team work co-ordinator at the ININOVA Institute. In the ESPRIT II basic research BLEARN II N° BR7274, he carried out all the work for the application of machine learning paradigms in the supervision of CNC machining processes. He has also participated in the CYTED-D* Iberoamerican Project for Science and Technology Development, as a member of the sub-project “Técnicas de Inteligência Artificial En Control Industrial” in 1990. Since there he has been engaged in the “Rede Iberoamericana de Sistemas de Informática Industrial - RISII” science co-operation network (1991-1996) under the scope of the CYTED-D programme. His main research areas are: Distributed Operating Systems and Networks, Physical computing, Real-time embedded systems and Intelligent Sensors. He is the author of seven papers in specialised magazines, and more than fifty papers in proceedings of conferences, one educational book, and more than 20 internal reports.
